

## General information about the assessment

- The Q&A, Puppy Consultation and Practical Dog Training Session are in person or on zoom with your assessor, each part is 20 minutes. The group class video is set up and recorded by you and then sent into us for assessing, this is a 30-minute group class.
- Assessment via Zoom:
  - You will receive a zoom link (if assessing via Zoom) from your assessor 2 days before your assessment, please check your junk folders if you haven't received and otherwise email <a href="woof@imdt.com.au">woof@imdt.com.au</a>
  - Please don't wait until the day before your assessment to contact us if you haven't received your zoom link
  - Please have your mobile phone with you and have access to your emails in the unlikely event we have any technical issues
  - Please ensure you have practised with your device and your microphone and video are working on zoom. Also have a back up device just in case.
  - o As you click through with your zoom link say yes to any audio and video access
- Please arrive at the allocated time for the in person or online assessment, this will give you time to have an introduction with your assessor.
- You will be asked to make sure you are alone, and all other devices are off during the Assessment and to show the assessor around your desk area.
- For the Q&A you can have a blank piece of paper and for the other sections you can have your consultation sheet – no other notes are permitted
- Orientate yourself with the timing of each section
- You will need to be aware of and manage your own time during each part of the assessment
- Please bring all your training kit as if you were doing the assessment in person
- Please be aware each section of the assessment is recorded these recordings are for the
  assessment process only and remain the property of the IMDT and will be kept for 6 weeks
  following your assessment
- Your results will be emailed to you within 4 weeks of the assessment date
- Please be aware of the IMDT code of ethics
- You are not allowed to record the Assessment.
- Your Assessment is confidential, you do not have permission to share the content.
- By attending the Assessment you are agreeing to the Assessment terms and conditions laid out above.
